- We have developed prototype solutions for identifying the floor in a multistory building on which an emergency caller can be found
- This year we hosted **HackRTC**, a hackathon devoted to developing prototype applications integrating AI, and other cutting edge technologies with real-time multimedia communications. You will hear from the winners during the WebRTC Track at 1:30 PM Tuesday.



- For the past couple of years Co-Director, <u>Vijay Gurbani</u>, the Chief Data Scientist at <u>Vail Systems</u> and a Research Associate Professor in the CS Department at IIT, and long-time colleague and friend has been integral to the success of lab projects.
- In our roles as Research Associate Professors, both Vijay and I are focused on expanding the lab's research and development programs.
- We see this conference as an important venue in which to find both inspiration and collaboration.



• We hope that this conference continues to provide a forum for all our participants, in which we explore not only current and future technologies, innovations and entrepreneurial initiatives but also the societal impacts of these developments and our role in shaping them.





